We are letting our customers know that we have identified a behavior in the browser interface of HULFT-WebFileTransfer in which HTML tags are recognized as HTML tags when specified in certain items.

This issue occurs under the conditions described below.

Please implement the corrected version released this time.

■Occurrence Event

In HULFT-WebFileTransfer, HTML tags specified by users for certain items may be recognized as HTML tags as they are instead of as text strings.

■ Applicable Products and Versions

HULFT-WebFileTransfer Ver.3.0.0∼Ver.3.3.0

■Occurrence Condition

This may occur when all of the following conditions are met

- The user specifies information containing HTML tags for a particular item.
- · Using the browser interface screen

■Cause

Some items were being recognized as HTML tags.

■Workaround

There is no workaround.

■Support

Ver. 3.3.0A has been modified to display the input string as a string even if HTML tags are specified in the input string; please consider installing the new version.

However, functions designed to be handled as HTML tags, including screen customization of the browser interface, will continue to be recognized as HTML tags rather than strings.
